RULES

This is not an ordinary cooking contest! This contest requires you to use one or more of the 2024 Girl Scout cookies in your entry. No need to be a Girl Scout or a girl. Download the required entry form from www.lightkeeper.net.

Entry Requirements

- \$6 fee per entry (scholarships available, contact Lynne Lowe at lynnelowe2010@gmail.com)
- Each entry must be submitted in only one flavor category (even if more than one flavor cookie is included).
- Entries may be submitted by individuals or teams of two.
- Each entry must be submitted in only one age category. If working as a team, use the age category of the oldest team member.
- Adults may supervise and provide safety oversight for youth entries without being classified as a team.
- Up to two entries per person/team are allowed.
- Fill out an entry form for each entry you enter in the contest.
- The recipe, including a list of ingredients, must accompany each entry.
- The entry must be in the name of the person who made it.
- Submit entry form(s)/fee(s) by April 1st, 2024 by mailing to Lynne Lowe, 60 Tanglewood Court, Lebanon, PA 17042.

Entry

- Other than the Girl Scout cookies, the entry must be made from scratch.
- The entry can be a dessert, main dish, side dish, salad, appetizer, or even soup.
- The entry must include at least one of the 2024 Girl Scout cookies.
- The entry should contain at least 12 servings.
- Entries must be submitted at a proper temperature for the type of entry.
- Please label all pans or consider using disposable pans.

Judging and Prizes

A panel of judges from the community will judge the entries. This is a blind judging, and all decisions of the judges are final. Winners will be announced after the judging is complete.

- All entries must be submitted between 5:00 and 5:30 pm on the day of the contest at the Fellowship Hall of Cornwall United Methodist Church, 50 Freeman Drive, Cornwall, PA 17042.
- There will be a minimum of 2 judges per category.
- Judging criteria will include overall presentation, taste, and creativity.
- Scoring: Each judge will assign a numerical value (1-5) in each category without consultation with the other judges. The entry receiving the highest total numerical value will be the winner in that category. In the case of a tie, the judges will judge those entries again.
- Entries will be judged by BOTH Age Group and Flavor Category.
- Winners in each category will receive prizes.
- Grand-Prize winner: Each category-winning entry will be judged again. Judges will decide which entries are the Grand, Second, and Third Overall Winners.
- All winners will be announced after the judging. A press release and photo may be released to local media outlets for publication. Social media posts are also a possibility.

Health Regulations

- Entries must be maintained and submitted at a proper temperature as determined by health department regulations for the ingredients used in the entry.
- Because of facility limitations, frozen entries cannot be accepted.
- A list of ingredients must be submitted with the entry.

We ask that everyone remain at the church while entries are being judged (approximately 5:30-6:30pm). There will be a variety of activities to keep you busy including a trivia contest, craft station, and coloring station. Depending on the number of entries, we anticipate announcing winners starting at approximately 6:45pm. To close the evening, guests will be allowed to sample a few of the entries. By participating in this event, entrants agree to abide by the contest rules and decisions of the judges, to allow organizers to publish photographs of them and their entry, and to allow their entry to be included in a *potential* future cookbook.
